HOW IT WORKS?

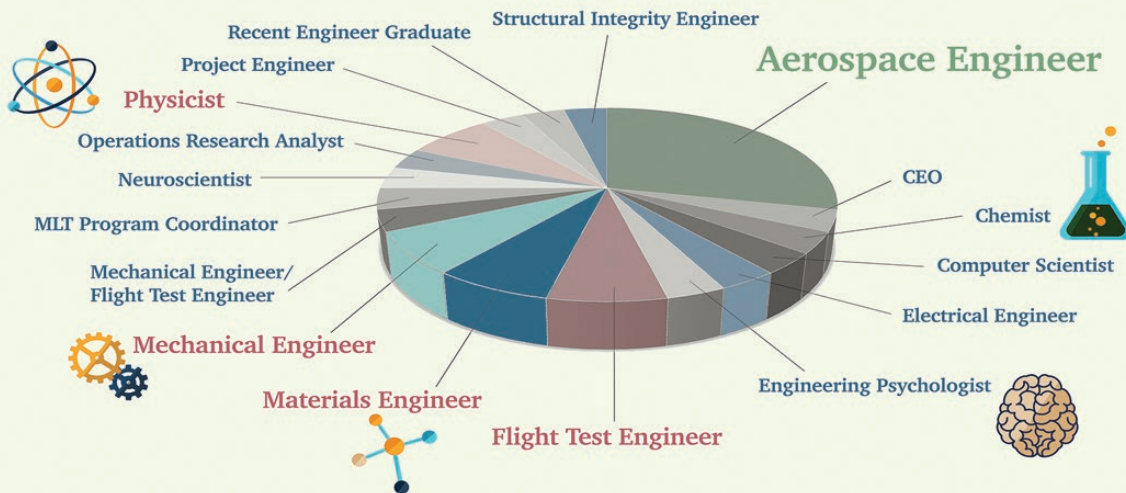
